

***Passport to Adaptive Living*** (PAL) has immediate openings for enthusiastic individuals seeking employment opportunities as Instructors in the field of behavioral health services for individuals with developmental disabilities. Employment opportunities are available in Santa Barbara, Ventura County, and North Los Angeles County.

### ***Instructors I & II***

As an Instructor, prospective staff will be teaching individuals with autism and other developmental disabilities functional skills that improve their quality of life. Instructors work with individuals (age 3 years old – adulthood) 1-1 or in a group in the home, community, or school environments. Instructors are mainly responsible for implementing intensive behavior intervention programs, social skills programs, and adaptive skills programs under the supervision of a clinical program coordinator.

***This is a part time hourly position*** and a perfect opportunity for undergraduate and graduate students looking for a start in the helping profession. Extensive training is provided upon hire. Training consists of classroom lecture, role play, and onsite shadowing.

Applicants for ***Instructor I or Instructor II positions*** must submit a 1 page resume, must qualify for the following prerequisites, and be able to present a copy of the following items upon interview:

#### ***Those who apply for an Instructor I position must have:***

- A minimum of 55 college units in a related field
- Valid CA driver's license, proof of automobile insurance, & reliable transportation
- Social Security Card or Valid Passport
- Most recent college transcripts (Unofficial are okay)
- 1 letter of reference

Those who apply for an Instructor II position must have:

- A minimum of BA degree in a related field + 18 months of practical field experience
- Valid CA driver's license, proof of automobile insurance, & reliable transportation
- Social Security Card or Valid Passport
- Most recent college transcripts (Unofficial are okay)
- 1 letter of reference
- ***Applicants must be available and willing to work week day afternoons/evenings and weekend hours. Morning hours are also available***

***Hourly Wage:*** Starting wage is \$14/hr to \$18/hr + Mileage and Drive Time for in-between travel. Wages are dependent upon combined education and experience supporting individuals with developmental disabilities. If candidates have experience, they may qualify for a higher rate. No experience necessary (40 hour training is provided)

Upon hire you will be expected to obtain finger print clearance, TB clearance, and attend training. Training is mandatory and will be discussed upon interview
